- Man Lift
- CSTS
- Fall Protection
- 2 Proofs of Residence for subsistence pay at \$120/day for days worked (i.e.: Income Tax Assessment, Property Tax Assessment, Utility Bill, EI document) 2 of the following 4 documents will be all that will be accepted. Please note that Cell Phone Bills will NOT be accepted.

All Iron Workers planning on travelling to Local 771 for work **MUST** be able to **PASS** a **DRUG & ALCOHOL** Test. Those who do not successfully pass the Drug & Alcohol test will be fined and will **NOT** be dispatched for work.

Have Members call Colin or Ryan at the Local 771 Union Hall *prior* to showing up in Regina during our Dispatch Hours; 8:00AM – 10:00AM and 2:00PM – 4:00PM Saskatchewan Time. Please do **NOT** call between 10:00Am and 2:00PM as our Dispatch will not be open.
